BYLAW No. 3

A Bylaw to Provide for the Payment of Indemnities
to the Members of the Wells District Council.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 185 of the Municipal Act, the Council of the District of Wells is empowered to provide for the payment of an annual indemnity to the Mayor and Councillors of the District of Wells, a part of which may be an allowance for expenses incidental to their duties;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the District of Wells in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. The annual indemnity paid to the Mayor shall be the sum of TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS, (\$2,000.00) effective July 1, 1998, also paid monthly.
2. The annual indemnity paid to each Councillor shall be the sum of ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$1,500.00) effective July 1, 1998, also paid monthly.
3. One-third of such annual indemnity amounts paid to each member of Council shall be paid as an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of his or her office.
4. This Bylaw shall remain in effect until amended or repealed.
5. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Council Indemnity Bylaw #3, 1998".
