

**DISTRICT OF WELLS
BYLAW NO. 101, 2009**

**A Bylaw to Provide for the Payment of Indemnities
to the Members of the Wells District Council**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Community Charter, the Council of the District of Wells is empowered to provide for the payment of an annual indemnity to the Mayor and Councillors of the District of Wells, a part of which may be an allowance for expenses incidental to their duties;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the District of Wells in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. There shall be paid out of annual revenues an annual remuneration to Council members for the discharge of the duties of office as provided for in Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of this bylaw;
2. Council Indemnity Bylaw No. 83, 2007 is hereby repealed.
3. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Council Indemnities Bylaw No. 101, 2009".

Schedule "A"

A. REMUNERATION AND INCIDENTAL EXPENSES EFFECTIVE APRIL 7, 2009

REMUNERATION TO COUNCIL MEMBERS

- (a) That the Mayor of the Municipality shall be paid an annual indemnity of Six Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$6,900.00).
- (b) That each Councillor of the Municipality shall be paid an annual indemnity of Two Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$2,700.00).

INCIDENTAL EXPENSES

That a portion of the remuneration for the Mayor and Council set out above is an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of office, other than actual expenses incurred by the member of Council established as follows:

- (a) An allowance of Two Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$2,300.00) shall be an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of the Mayor.
- (b) An allowance of Nine Hundred Dollars (\$900.00) shall be an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of each of the Councillors.

B. REMUNERATION AND INCIDENTAL EXPENSES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2010

REMUNERATION TO COUNCIL MEMBERS

- (a) That the Mayor of the Municipality shall be paid an annual indemnity of Seven Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$7,200.00).
- (b) That each Councillor of the Municipality shall be paid an annual indemnity of Two Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$2,850.00).

INCIDENTAL EXPENSES

That a portion of the remuneration for the Mayor and Council set out above is an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of office, other than actual expenses incurred by the member of Council established as follows:

- (a) An allowance of Two Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$2,400.00) shall be an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of the Mayor.

- (b) An allowance of Nine Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$950.00) shall be an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of each of the Councillors.

C. REMUNERATION AND INCIDENTAL EXPENSES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2011

REMUNERATION TO COUNCIL MEMBERS

- (a) That the Mayor of the Municipality shall be paid an annual indemnity of Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$7,500.00).
- (b) That each Councillor of the Municipality shall be paid an annual indemnity of Three Thousand Fifty Dollars (\$3,050.00).

INCIDENTAL EXPENSES

That a portion of the remuneration for the Mayor and Council set out above is an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of office, other than actual expenses incurred by the member of Council established as follows:

- (a) An allowance of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) shall be an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of the Mayor.
- (b) An allowance of One Thousand Sixteen Dollars and Sixty-Seven Cents (\$1,016.67) shall be an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of each of the Councillors.
