



**DISTRICT OF WELLS**  
**BYLAW NO. 115, 2011**

**A Bylaw to Provide for the Payment of Indemnities to the Members of the Wells District Council.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Community Charter, the Council of the District of Wells is empowered to provide for the payment of an annual indemnity to the Mayor and Councillors of the District of Wells, a part of which may be an allowance for expenses incidental to their duties;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the District of Wells in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. There shall be paid out of annual revenues an annual remuneration to Council members for the discharge of the duties of office as provided for in Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of this bylaw;
2. Council Indemnity Bylaw No. 101, 2009 is hereby repealed.
3. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Council Indemnities Bylaw No. 115, 2011".

READ A SECOND TIME THIS 18<sup>th</sup> DAY OF OCTOBER, 2011.

READ A THIRD TIME THIS 18<sup>th</sup> DAY OF OCTOBER, 2011.

FINALLY READ AND ADOPTED BY UNANIMOUS VOTE OF COUNCIL MEMBERS THIS 1<sup>ST</sup> DAY OF NOVEMBER, 2011.

## Schedule "A"

### **A. REMUNERATION AND INCIDENTAL EXPENSES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2012**

#### REMUNERATION TO COUNCIL MEMBERS

- (a) That the Mayor of the Municipality shall be paid an annual indemnity of Seven Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars (\$7,725.00).
- (b) That each Councillor of the Municipality shall be paid an annual indemnity of Three Thousand One Hundred Forty Dollars (\$3,140.00).

#### INCIDENTAL EXPENSES

That a portion of the remuneration for the Mayor and Council set out above is an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of office, other than actual expenses incurred by the member of Council established as follows:

- (a) An allowance of Two Thousand Five Hundred and Seventy-Five Dollars (\$2,575.00) shall be an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of the Mayor.
- (b) An allowance of One Thousand Forty-Six Dollars and Sixty-Seven Cents (\$1046.67) shall be an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of each of the Councillors.

### **B. REMUNERATION AND INCIDENTAL EXPENSES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2013**

#### REMUNERATION TO COUNCIL MEMBERS

- (a) That the Mayor of the Municipality shall be paid an annual indemnity of Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty-Five Dollars (\$7,955.00).
- (b) That each Councillor of the Municipality shall be paid an annual indemnity of Three Thousand Two Hundred Thirty-Five Dollars (\$3,235.00).

#### INCIDENTAL EXPENSES

That a portion of the remuneration for the Mayor and Council set out above is an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of office, other than actual expenses incurred by the member of Council established as follows:

- (a) An allowance of Two Thousand Six Hundred and Fifty- One Dollars and Sixty-Seven Cents (\$2,651.67) shall be an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of the Mayor.
- (b) An allowance of One Thousand Seventy-Eight Dollars and Thirty-Three (\$1078.33) shall be an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of each of the Councillors.

**C. REMUNERATION AND INCIDENTAL EXPENSES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2014**

REMUNERATION TO COUNCIL MEMBERS

- (a) That the Mayor of the Municipality shall be paid an annual indemnity of Eight Thousand One Hundred Ninety-Five Dollars (\$8,195.00).
- (b) That each Councillor of the Municipality shall be paid an annual indemnity of Three Thousand Three Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$3,330.00).

INCIDENTAL EXPENSES

That a portion of the remuneration for the Mayor and Council set out above is an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of office, other than actual expenses incurred by the member of Council established as follows:

- (a) An allowance of Two Thousand Seven Hundred and Thirty-One Dollars and Sixty-Seven Cents (\$2,731.67) shall be an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of the Mayor.
- (b) An allowance of One Thousand One Hundred and Ten Dollars (\$1,110.00) shall be an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of each of the Councillors.
