

**DISTRICT OF WELLS  
BYLAW NO. 32**

**A Bylaw of Provide for the Payment of Indemnities  
to the Members of the Wells District Council**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Local Government Act, the Council of the District of Wells is empowered to provide for the payment of an annual indemnity to the Mayor and Councillors of the District of Wells, a part of which may be an allowance for expenses incidental to their duties;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the District of Wells in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. The annual indemnity paid to the Mayor shall be the sum of TWO THOUSAND AND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS, (\$2,500.00) retroactive to January 1, 2000, also paid monthly.
2. The annual indemnity paid to each Councillor shall be the sum of ONE THOUSAND and SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$1,600.00), retroactive to January 1, 2000, also paid monthly.
3. One-third of such annual indemnity amounts paid to each member of Council shall be paid as an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of his or her office.
4. Council Indemnity Bylaw No. 3, 1998 is hereby repealed.
5. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Council Indemnity Bylaw No. 32, 2000.
