

**DISTRICT OF WELLS**

**BYLAW No. 55, 2003**

**A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE THE DISTRICT OF WELLS TO OBTAIN,  
BY REFERENDUM, THE OPINION OF THE ELECTORS**

**WHEREAS** Section 245 of the Local Government Act provides that Council may, by bylaw, provide for a referendum to obtain the electors' opinions on a question that affects the municipality and with which the Council has the power to deal;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the District of Wells, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as "Barkerville Referendum Bylaw No. 55, 2003".

2. There shall be submitted to the electors of the District of Wells at the referendum, to be held on Saturday, June 14, 2003, the following question:

"Should the District of Wells enter into a long-term contract with the Provincial Government to manage the Barkerville Historic Town providing this can be done at no cost to District of Wells taxpayers?"

3. That Gary Champagne is appointed as the Chief Elections Officer for the Referendum and Neva Hohn is appointed as the Deputy Elections Officer.
