MUNICIPAL TICKET INFORMATION BYLAW NO. 94, 2008

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OF DESIGNATED BYLAWS BY MEANS OF A TICKETING SYSTEM (MTI).

WHEREAS pursuant to section 264 of the *Community Charter*, the Council of the District of Wells may, by bylaw, designate those bylaws for which Municipal Ticket Information may be used as a means of bylaw enforcement;

AND WHEREAS the *Community Charter* empowers the Council, by bylaw, to authorize the use of any word or expression on a Municipal Ticket Information to designate an offence against a bylaw;

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it expedient to authorize the use of Municipal Ticket Information for the enforcement of certain bylaws, to authorize the use of certain words or expressions to designate certain bylaw offences, and to set certain fine amounts;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the District of Wells, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That the bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule A, attached to and forming part of this bylaw, as amended from time to time, may be enforced by means of a ticket in the form prescribed for the purpose pursuant to Chapter 26, Part 8, Division 3 of the *Community Charter*.
2. That the persons appointed to the job positions or titles listed in Column 2 of Schedule A of this bylaw, are designated as Bylaw Enforcement Officers pursuant to Chapter 26, Part 8, Division 3, Section 264,1(b) of the *Community Charter* for the purpose of enforcing the bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule A of this bylaw, opposite the respective job positions.
3. That the words or expressions set forth in Column 1 of Schedules B, C, D and E attached to and forming part of this bylaw, pursuant to Chapter 26, Part 8, Division 3, Section 264, 1(c) of the *Community Charter* designate the offences committed under the bylaw section numbers appearing in Column 2 of Schedules B, C, D and E of this bylaw, opposite the respective words or expressions.

4. That the amounts appearing in Column 3 of Schedules B, C, D and E of this bylaw, are the fines set pursuant to Chapter 26, Part 8, Division 1, Section 265, 1(a) of the Community Charter for the corresponding offences designated in Column 1.
5. That this bylaw shall be cited as "District of Wells Municipal Ticket Information Bylaw No. 94, 2008."
6. District of Wells Bylaw Number 53, cited as "District of Wells Municipal Ticket Information Bylaw No. 53, 2003," and all amendments thereto, is hereby repealed.
7. This bylaw shall take effect upon the date of its adoption.

Severability

8. If any portion of this bylaw is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, then the invalid portion must be severed and the remainder of the bylaw is deemed valid.

READ A THIRD TIME this 3rd day of June, 2008.
